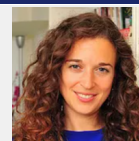
Lies, damned lies, and newspapers /

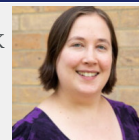
Risk and Reward /

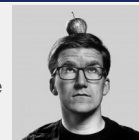
The (little) Big Maths Gameshow /
